SUBJECT: Decission

Dear Mr. Obon

DECISION:

The Disciplinary and Ethical Committee of WAKO decides that:

No disciplinary proceedings are opened in respect of Mr. Daniel Obon's complaint of 12th March 2024 and the complaint is dismissed.
The procedural fee of € 500 will not be refunded.

REASON:

Article 17 of the Code defines the necessary content of a complaint as follows:

17.2. The claim of the Claimant must contain:

- the name and full address of the Claimant and respondent;

- a brief statement of the facts and legal argument, including a statement of the issue submitted to the DEC for determination;

- any relevant information or proof;

17.3. The Complaint must be accompanied by a non-refundable \$500 (or the equivalent amount in Euro) processing fee net of any bank charges. This fee can be waived based on special circumstances. To receive such a waiver the Claimant must provide adequate grounds. The above fee will be reimbursed in case of positive outcome of the Complaint in favor of the Claimant.

The complaint does not fulfil the requirements of Article 17 of the WAKO Disciplinary Code. Mr Obon has failed to name a person against whom his complaint is directed despite repeated requests to do so.
