Decision

The Disciplinary Committee of WAKO temporarily suspends Mister Jörg Barutzki for a period of 3 years from exercising the following rights:

a) The right to organize any international WAKO competition or event;

b) The right to vote in a Committee of WAKO;

c) The right to compete or take part in any international event or Championship of WAKO or in any other international competition recognized by WAKO.

Reasons for the decision:

WAKO Germany as the the Claimant has written to WAKO on 5th of August, that they have sanctioned a German member named Mr. Jörg Barutzki because he has beaten in the German championship a female person in the face.

The lawyer of Mr Barautzki has questioned that WAKO Germany could not impose a global ban. Therefore, WAKO Germany files an application that WAKO IF impose a global ban (including a house ban for all WAKO events).

The body responsible for the application and implementation of the provisions of the Code regarding disciplinary matters is the Disciplinary Committee.

The behavior of Mr Barutzki can damage the image of our sport seriously.

Art 6 of the Disciplinary Code regulates that in the cases other than those indicated in paragraph 3, the competent WAKO Committee may temporarily suspend a Subject for a maximum period from 2 up to maximum 5 years.



For your information:

Decisions passed by the Disciplinary Committee may be appealed before the Arbitration Committee within 30 days of notification of the decision to the parties, save for what is provided in Article 2, paragraph 3. The appeal must contain the reasons that justify the appeal. The appellant must deposit a sum of \$500 (five hundred \$) to WAKO bank account. This sum will be reimbursed to the appellant in the case of a favourable decision. The appeal will not suspend the decision of the Disciplinary Committee, except when the Disciplinary Committee decides so, upon justified and grounded request of the appellant. The appeal procedure to be followed will be the same as for the first instance.
