



WAKO 2016 ANTIDOPING ACTIVITY REPORT

WAKO IF Antidoping policy for year 2016 was to test athletes at World and Continental Championship. Therefore, 10 athletes were tested per each of the following events:

CADETS AND JUNIOR WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP (event held in Dublin, Ireland)
SENIOR EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP (LC, LK, K-1) (event held in Maribor, Slovenia)
SENIOR EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP (PF, KL, FC, MF) (event held in Loutraki, Greece)

5 of these tests were classified as Out Of Competition, OOC (samples collected at weigh-in and medical check, before the competitions started) and 5 In Competition, IC (samples collected on winners, just after the final matches). The tests were made on urine samples.

Asian Kickboxing Confederation, affiliated to WAKO, also organized 12 In Competition tests at **Asian K1 Championships** which were held in Seoul, Korea. The samples were collected on winner after the final matches.

Additionally, WAKO had a Registered Testing Pool (RTP) of athletes, to be tested Out Of Competition. Their tests were coordinated for WAKO by the GAISF Doping Free Sport Unit. Each athlete was tested 3 times in the year. Steroidal Module of Athlete Biological Passport was also implemented.

ANTIDOPING RULE VIOLATIONS

- One athlete from the RTP committed 3 Whereabouts violations;
- 2 Adverse Analytical Findings (AAF) were reported at the Asian K1 Championships.

All these cases were reviewed by the WAKO Hearing Panel and final decision was taken in 2017.

Based on the above mention data, the AAF rate in OOC tests was **0%** during 2016, while the AAF rate at IC tests was **7%**.
