# SCHEDULE OF THE EVENT:

# **ATHLETES AND COACHES**

#### **ACCOMMODATION:**

**Accommodation of all teams (athletes and coaches),** will be provided based on full board (single, double or triple rooms) in **Boutique Solo Hotel**, Address: Kwiska 1/3, 54-210 Wrocław, Poland Phone: +48 71 351 70 11

You have already been informed about composition of rooms for each participating country. Rooming list was made according to your registration. Some small changes in rooming list upon arrival according to your needs will be allowed but *not changes in structure and composition of rooms*.

#### **REGISTRATION:**

**Registration of all teams (athletes and coaches),** will be in Boutique Solo Hotel upon arrival. As soon as you arrive you will meet our staff in the lobby of the hotel where you will be delivered your accreditation cards (MANDATORY KEEP IT WITH YOU during whole period of your stay in Wroclaw) and accommodation vouchers. After accommodation in your rooms you will proceed with medical check and weigh in for athletes.

#### **WEIGH IN:**

All participating athletes will have to pass official weigh in according to their registration. There will be *no tolerance* on the weight of athlete. We will provide control scales for weigh in check which will be placed in front of weigh in office. Athletes will have right to control their weight as much as it necessary but *official weigh in* be allowed only once.

All athletes *must* be in possession of *WAKO Liability Waiver* (attached to this letter) that must be delivered to weigh in officer on the spot.

Weigh in on arrival day will be valid for the first day of competition, July 26<sup>th</sup> (quarter and semifinals).

Weigh in for the second day of competition, July 27<sup>th</sup> will be organized according to the schedule.

#### **MEDICAL CHECK:**

All participating athletes will have to pass medical check. All athletes *must* be in possession of *WAKO Medical Form* (attached to this letter) which must be delivered to official doctor on spot. **WEIGH IN and MEDICAL CHECK** will be organized in separate rooms for male and female kickboxers on following way:

Sunday, July 23<sup>rd</sup> from 16:00 pm to 21:30 pm Monday, July 24<sup>th</sup> from 11:00 am to 20:00 pm

#### **UNIFORMS:**

After completing weigh in and medical check all athletes will be delivered *Official competition* uniform (shorts for male kickboxers and shorts and top for female kickboxers) provided by Official WAKO Safety Supplier TOP TEN in red and blue color.

<u>Official Competition Uniform</u> is the only uniform that you are allowed to fight in. It is not allowed to fight in any other uniform but this one. Athletes are allowed to wear their National tracksuit or t-shirt.

During competition days in Orbita hall all athletes and coaches are kindly requested to be dressed according to WAKO rules.

Coaches can assist their kickboxers during the fight only if they are dressed in following manner:

- National tracksuit or t-shirt (not allowed club or any other tracksuit or t-shirt)
- National tracksuit (not allowed jeans, pants or shorts while coaching)
- Sport shoes (not allowed slippers or shoes)
- No any kind of hat

After each three finals three Medal Ceremonies will follow for those categories.

Medal Ceremonies will be organized according to IWGA procedure. All medalist must be present at the time of Medal Ceremony dressed in National tracksuit only (no slippers, jeans, t-shirts, hats...allowed).

It is not allowed to stand on the Medal Podium with National flag around shoulders.

*Information* about procedure to collect your Accreditation No. 4 will follow and you will be informed on time.

# **INSURANCE:**

Each World Games participant must be insured against the minimum costs of medical treatment. The most important is that the Insurance Policy will cover the costs of treatment in hospital, if needed (minimum value – 200 000 PLN/around 50 000 EUR). Of course any additional packages can be useful for the athletes, if they lose their luggage, have some accident outside of competition venue or after an injury need any special transportation to their countries/any additional, special treatment/equipment, etc.

In general it is the same Insurance Policy we (WAKO) always use for purpose of attending international competitions.

There will be the possibility to buy insurance in accreditation centers (cost ca. 40 euro/week). Minimum desired insurance coverage is 200 000 zł (50 000 euro). You have already been informed about this possibility. We recommend to all participants to purchase Insurance Policy before arriving to Wroclaw.
