








Finally, we inform that all the minutes of the board meetings are sent to WAKO IF.



















4. Event activity

The activities of WAKO Panam have increased each year. Most part of the countries have organized several national events, including official qualifying to the continental events, in which their participation have increased every year. In numbers:

- Pan-American Championship (Cancun, Mexico/2016): 816 athletes from 16 countries
- South-American Championship (Foz do Iguaçu, Brazil/2017): 690 athletes form 09 countries



In 2018, we increased the number of championships and tournaments and, in addition to that, WAKO Panam have organized several events aiming the technical capacitation in many countries.

















In addition to the events under amateur rules, which are our main focus, I would like to highlight the huge contribution that WGP Kickboxing is giving to promote and develop WAKO Kickboxing in all continent. It will be 10 editions in 2018, broadcasted live to Brazil by Bandsports, from Band to network, and Combate, from Globo media network (the same that has the rights to broadcast the UFC in Brazil), and to other 23 countries of the continent by Fox Sports.

With that, our Kickboxing is reaching millions of homes in the continent and opening the doors to WAKO to get stronger in our amateur modalities.





























05. Focus

For 2019, our main objectives are:

- to establish the National Referee's Academy program and, after that, to start developing a Pan-American Referee's Academy program.
- to establish the National Technical Academy and, after that, to start developing a Pan-American Technical Academy.



- to strengthen the relationship between WAKO and the National Universities Federations and, therefore, to strengthen the relationship with FISU America.
- to establish a big event in the three regions of the continent:

A – South America: the South-American Championship is already the most important championship of the region. The 10th edition in 2017 took place in Foz do Iguaçu, Brasil and the next one will be held in 2019 in Lima, Peru.

B – Central America and Caribbean: the CAC (Central American and Caribbean Open) will be the official event of the region and will be organized in different countries. This year, the event was held in Trinidad and Tobago and in 2019 It will be held in Guatemala. It will be organized every two years,




























in odd years, to obey WAKO IF calendar, which determines that the continental championships for adults must be organized in odd years.

- C North America: we will bring the three countries closer (Mexico, USA and Canada) and we will organize the first official edition of the North-American Championship in 2019.
- To establish the South-American Kickboxing Confederation. The current president of ODESUR (Organización Deportiva Suramericana), an entity which has 14 country members in the region, is Mr. Dom Camilo Perez, president of the Paraguayan Olympic Committee, where WAKO Panam has one of its Training Centers.
- Dom Camilo requested the foundation of the South-American Confederation, since it can be a member of ODESUR and, with that membership, WAKO Kickboxing can be eligible to participate as a demonstration sport at the South American Games, which will be held in 2022, in Asuncion, Paraguay.
- To give all the support to our members so they can achieve the recognition towards their Sports Ministry or National Olympic Committee. This year, Mexico, Brazil, Argentina and Guatemala achieved that recognition.
- to strengthen the relation with ODEPA, but in this case, we will need all the support from WAKO If and, specially, from our vice-president Mr. Espen Lund.
